## Single Occupancy

All rates are based on double occupancy in a stateroom. #### Third and Fourth Guests

Triple and quadruple accommodations are subject to availability at the time of booking and are not guaranteed. Prices will vary for additional guests per stateroom.

## **Deposits and Final Payments**

A deposit of \$200.00 USD per stateroom is due once any booking is created within the BPA group. There is no penalty if you choose to pay in full.

To secure any held <u>inventory or group pricing</u>, deposits and full legal names are required NO LATER THAN Thursday, August 14, 2025, by 8:00 p.m. Eastern Time.

Final payment for all remaining amounts is due <u>NO LATER THAN Monday, November</u> 3, 2025, by 8:00 p.m. Eastern Time.

The deposit amount for bookings created outside of the group or for suites may vary. Please refer to your individual booking invoice for details provided by Royal Caribbean at the time of booking. Any balance due after this date will result in the cancellation of your stateroom. All staterooms or additional components added to a group after the final payment date must be paid for in full.

#### **Quote Status**

Staterooms have been reserved for the <u>BPA 2026 Winter Board Meeting</u> and are subject to availability at the time of booking. <u>Pricing and availability after August 14, 2025</u>, are determined by the price in effect on the day of booking.

## Taxes, Fees, and Port Expenses (in USD)

Taxes and Fees are based on USD per person. Royal Caribbean International shall be prepaid for all departure taxes, customs fees, airport facility charges, and any other applicable fees in effect at the time of sailing. Fees are subject to change without notice.

## Gratuities (in USD)

When booking, it is recommended that gratuities be prepaid per person for the entire cruise. If not prepaid prior to sailing, gratuities will be automatically added to each guest's SeaPass account once onboard. These gratuities are shared among dining, culinary services staff, stateroom attendants, and other hotel services teams who work behind the scenes to enhance the cruise experience.

To avoid charges, all cancellations must be made prior to the date of November 1, **2025**. ## Pregnancy and Infants

Royal Caribbean International cannot accept guests who will be more than 23 weeks pregnant at any time during the cruise or Cruise Tour. Guests will be required to fill out a Public Health Questionnaire prior to arrival or at the pier attesting that they are not more than 23 weeks pregnant.

Infants sailing on a cruise must be at least 6 months old as of the first day of the cruise and/or CruiseTour. For transatlantic, transpacific, Hawaii, select South American and other selected cruises and/or CruiseTours, the infant must be at least 12 months old as of the first day of the cruise/CruiseTour. For the purposes of this policy, any cruise that has 3 or more days consecutive at sea will require infants to be 12 months old on the first day of the cruise/CruiseTour.



## Accessible Cruising

Upon request, every effort will be made to provide reasonable accommodations to meet the needs of our guests. Please note that not all accommodations may be able to be provided and that guests should be fit for travel. We do not require guests to travel with a companion; however, our personnel are not required to perform personal tasks. We encourage you to notify us of your needs at the time of booking, to review the availability of specific equipment or services. Please provide at least a 60-day notice if you need sign language interpreting services or at least a 30-day notice if you require special equipment or services.
